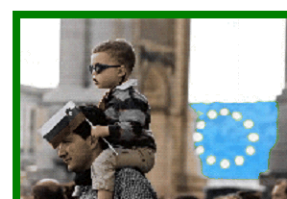
ULYSSES PROJECT
